



DTTNCo and Economic Committee of Yunnan Province signs Memoranda of Understanding on Logistics

Digital Trade and Transportation Network Limited (“DTTNCo”) and Economic Committee of Yunnan Province (“ECYP”) signed a Memoranda of Understanding (“MOU”) on Logistics on 4 June 2006 in Kunming.

The MOU mainly focuses on cooperation and future development of manpower training, information exchange, and applications of e-logistics and e-commerce. The MOU will provide impetus to mutual cooperation in the electronic logistics development between DTTNCo and ECYP. It will also reinforce the role of Hong Kong as a logistics hub in the region.

First of its kind in the world, DTTN is an electronic platform to facilitate trade and enhance the efficiency and productivity of the logistics sector. It seeks to provide a neutral, open and secure electronic platform to connect players along the supply chain, both in the region and globally. The MOU will help propel the extension of the electronic network from Hong Kong to other major markets in the region.

The signing was witnessed by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, Mr. Donald Tsang, and the Governor of Yunnan, Mr. Xu Rongkai.

Mr. Justin Yue, Chairman of DTTNCo, said, “We are proud to be one of the prominent players to have signed the MOU with the Economic Committee of Yunnan Province. We will share our experiences in e-commerce and e-logistics with our counterparts in Yunnan, and I trust our cooperation will bring mutual benefits to both economies. The MOU would lay a stronger foundation for cooperation between Hong Kong and Yunnan. In the

long term, we expect there will be other similar cooperation projects with other provinces in the Mainland.”
